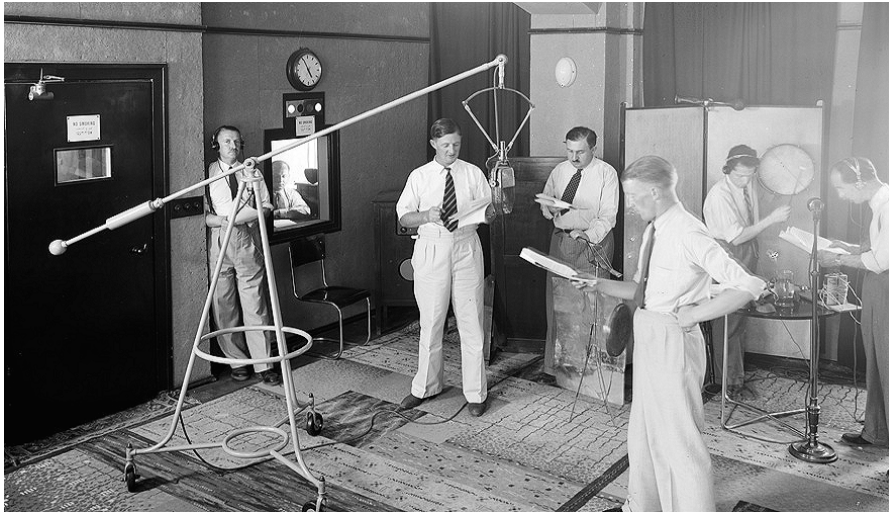


DONALD J. TRUMP RESIGNS U.S. PRESIDENCY TO BECOME CBS "BOARD" CHAIRMAN

ED SILVERMAN WINS CBS BOARD 'LIFETIME AWARD'

Silverman earned eleven Emmy Awards, the Albert Lasker Foundation Award for medical journalism and numerous other major awards for news and documentaries.



LORENZO VOWS FIGHT TO REGAIN POSITION

Lorenzo Stunned by Development

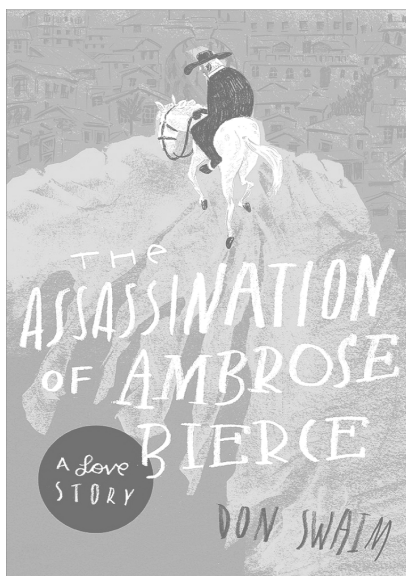
"Only Mexicans would swallow a deal so stupid," Mr. Trump said, adding that he knew a lot about stupid. "They could have had it for fifteen-hundred."

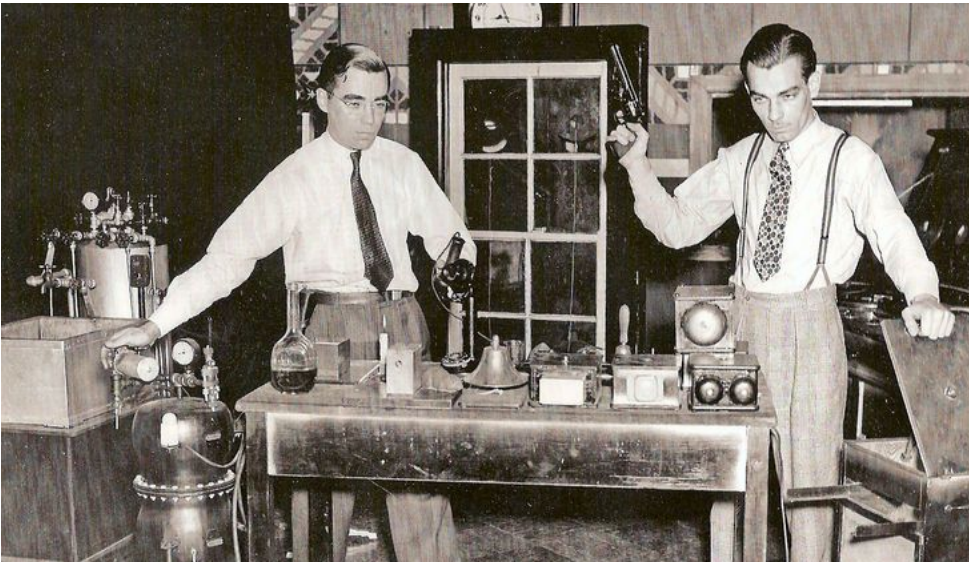

CBS Board Chairman For Life Donald J. Trump accuses *The New York Crimes* of spreading false news and scattering lies.

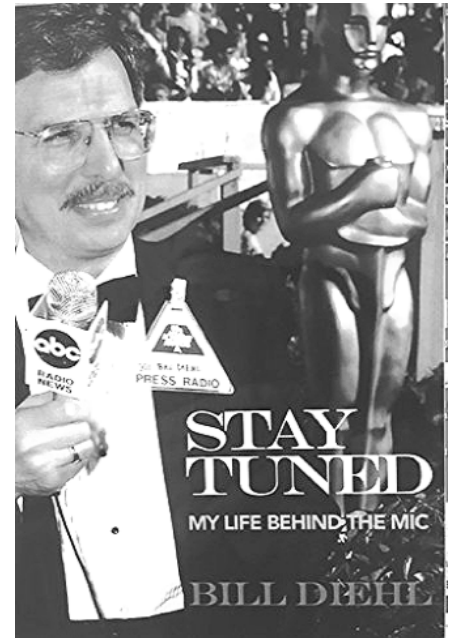

"Something is going on," Mr. Trump said, "and we have to get to the bottom of it."

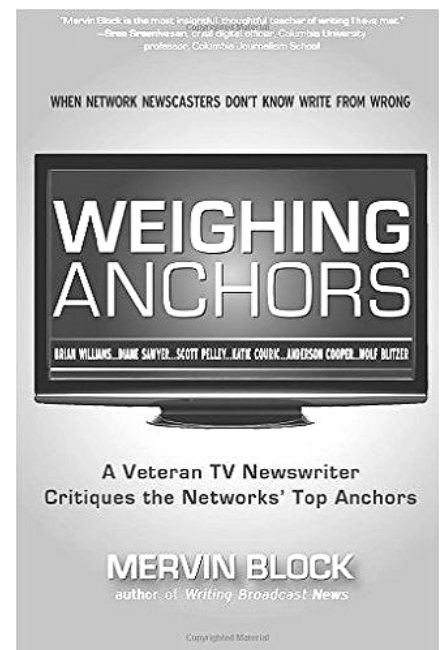
When asked specifically which news media are enemies, Mr. Trump cited 650 news sources, print and broadcast.



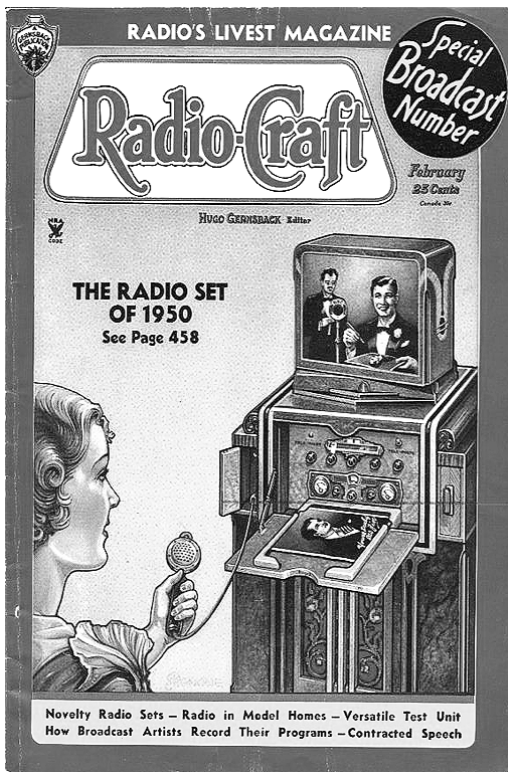

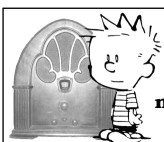
